# UGA Franklin College-University of Liverpool Doctoral Student Short-Term International Research Fellowship

**Application Deadline: Tuesday 31 October 2017** 

The week-long Franklin College-University of Liverpool Doctoral Short-Term International Research Fellowship, or "Franklin-Liverpool Fellowship," is open to Ph.D. students in any discipline in the College. Through this Fellowship program, students will have the opportunity to conduct research and develop an international network of research contacts. Fellows are expected to be on the Liverpool campus for one business week. The University of Liverpool seeks to host Franklin-Liverpool Fellows in March or April of 2018.

#### **Expenses Covered**

The Franklin College will reserve and pay for international airfare between Atlanta and Liverpool. The College will also reimburse Fellows for costs incurred in applying for a <u>UK Visitor Visa</u> (required by the University of Liverpool, where applicable), at a current cost of about \$425. The University of Liverpool will provide overnight accommodation for the one-week duration of the stay. Fellows are responsible for booking and paying for ground transportation between Athens and the Atlanta airport, and between Liverpool and the Manchester airport. Meals are not covered by this program.

### **Liverpool Faculty Mentor and UGA Approval**

Students applying will need to have obtained the written endorsement of a faculty mentor at the University of Liverpool (<a href="https://www.liverpool.ac.uk/a-z/academic/">https://www.liverpool.ac.uk/a-z/academic/</a>), indicating that the faculty member is willing to serve as a mentor for the time of the student's week-long visit.

Approval for the scheduled week-long visit must be obtained from both the student's major professor and the respective UGA department head. A UGA department may put forward up to two applications for this Fellowship each year.

#### **Activities at Liverpool**

While at Liverpool, students are expected to

- conduct research in consultation with the selected faculty mentor;
- offer a public lecture (or equivalent presentation) about their research;
- meet with faculty and graduate students to discuss longer-term research collaborations.

Applications will be reviewed by the Franklin International Studies Committee, which is chaired by Associate Dean Martin Kagel. Students will be notified of this decision by **Monday 27 November 2017**.
